1. Murti GWWC PLC JV with Asfaw Fikadu GC

- ✓ The bidder failed to use the prescribed Letter of Bid form as provided in the bidding document. Instead, the bidder submitted an altered Letter of Bid, which differs from the given format. In accordance with ITB 12.1, the Letter of Bid form must be completed without any alteration to the text.
- ✓ Didn't submit Environmental declaration, ESHS past performance information for each member of the joint venture
- ✓ Murti GWWC submitted a business license issued by Gelan of the Sheger City Administration under a JV with Asfaw Fikadu GC. However, the Tax Clearance Certificate was issued by the Sebata branch of the Sheger City Administration Revenue Authority. Since a tax clearance certificate must be obtained from the revenue authority responsible for the same location where the business is legally licensed and registered, this inconsistency indicates a lack of regulatory compliance. Accordingly, the submission does not meet the required legal and compliance standards. Furthermore, the bidder failed to submit a valid tax clearance certificate for Murti GWWC.
- ✓ The bidder failed to submit the litigation history.
- ✓ Failed to submit pending litigation for JV member

2. Keneni Construction JV with Bulti Contractor PLC

- ✓ The bidder failed to use the prescribed Letter of Bid form as provided in the bidding document. Instead, the bidder submitted an altered Letter of Bid, which differs from the given format. In accordance with ITB 12.1, the Letter of Bid form must be completed without any alteration to the text.
- ✓ Failed to complete the Section IV forms related to pending litigation, litigation history, and non-performing contracts. Failed to submit as per requirement
- ✓ The bidder did not submit the original site visit certificate and instead provided only a scanned copy.
- ✓ Failed to submit a tax clearance certificate.

3. Loyaland Engineering PLC

- ✓ Failed to submit the litigation history.

4. Negera Busha GWWC

- ✓ The bidder failed to use the prescribed Letter of Bid form as provided in the bidding document. Instead, the bidder submitted an altered Letter of Bid, which differs from the given format. In accordance with ITB 12.1, the Letter of Bid form must be completed without any alteration to the text.
- ✓ Failed to complete the litigation history form; only an unfilled form was attached.

Remarks for Non-Responsive Bidders

1. Yabkon Construction and Engineering

- The bidder submitted work experience documents for projects that were not executed by the bidder.
- Did not submit specific experience in key activities under Clause 4.2(b) and failed to use the prescribed form in Section IV.

2. Hydrosilas WWC PLC

- Did not submit information on executed projects, such as agreement documents and payment certificates.
- The bidder submitted work experience documents for projects that were not executed by the bidder

3. Fira Engineering

- ✓ The bidder submitted fake work experience information. For instance, the Sude SSIP project was executed at a contract value of ETB 3,090,611.40; however, the bidder reported the project value as ETB 55 million.
- ✓ The bidder submitted work experience documents for projects not executed by the bidder, which indicates misrepresentation of experience

4. Dawit Abdissa GWWC

- ✓ The bidder failed to submit the original bank confirmation letter and the bank statement for verification of available cash at hand
- ✓ The bidder submitted work experience documents for projects that were not executed by the bidder for both general experience and specific experience.

5. Getinet Kefyalew GC and WWC

- ✓ The contractor is requested to submit original documents of augamamit kebele WSP and Guay Wubshet kebele rehabilitation but not submitted so rejected as per (ITB 27.2) if a bidder does not provide clarification of its bid by the date and time set in the employer's request for clarification its bid may be rejected), the Employer formally requested for clarification on a specific point in the bidder's submitted documents. The bidder failed to respond within the specified time, and the bid was therefore considered non-responsive for non-compliance with the clarification request.

- ✓ The bidder failed to use the prescribed format stated in Section IV of the bidding document for submission of general and specific work experience.

5. Awash Construction plc.

- ✓ The bidder was not in the construction industry during the required period, and therefore does not meet the experience criteria stipulated in the bidding document, as the trade registration was issued in 2016.
- ✓ The work experience submitted by the bidder is inconsistent and supported by payment certificates that are neither approved nor certified by the authorized body

6. Getinet Kefyalew GC

- ✓ The contractor is requested to submit original documents of augamamit kebele WSP and Guay Wubshet kebele rehabilitation but not submitted so rejected as per (ITB 27.2) if a bidder does not provide clarification of its bid by the date and time set in the employer's request for clarification its bid may be rejected), the Employer formally requested for clarification on a specific point in the bidder's submitted documents. The bidder failed to respond within the specified time, and the bid was therefore considered non-responsive for non-compliance with the clarification request.

7. Wiirtuu Construction PLC

- ✓ The contractor is requested to submit original documents of Oromia source area community WSP Project Lot 1 but not submitted so rejected as per (ITB 27.2) if a bidder does not provide clarification of its bid by the date and time set in the employer's request for clarification its bid may be rejected),

8. Fanta Daba WWGC

- ✓ For the Construction Engineer, the attached work experience letter is only 5 months.
- ✓ Experience work of Forman is not full filled and it is only three months and submitted for the Forman is less than five years, Forman is not submitted as bid required and work Experience for chief surveyor is less than five years.
- ✓ Audit Submitted is Not done by Certified Auditor (Katama Baresa Balcha is not Certified auditor).



Remarks for Non-Responsive Bidders

1. Burka Gemechu WWC

- ✓ The bidder submitted fake /or invalid work experience. For example, the bidder submitted Waliso Woreda kume Badessa SSIP work experience that was executed by another contractor as a subcontract. Furthermore, the constructed amount was ETB 6,524,235.49 by Jelata Gemechu WWC, whereas the bidder misrepresented it as ETB 25 million, which indicates misrepresentation of experience
- ✓ The bidder didn't to submit the specific experience required under 4.2(b) of the bidding documents.

2. Tokuma Hirpha WWC

- ✓ The bidder failed to submit the Code of Conduct related to ESHS requirements.
- ✓ The specific work experience submitted under Clause 4.2(b) does not meet the experience criteria required by the bidding document. The bidder submitted the Welmel SSIP project, with a value of ETB 776,250, which does not meet the minimum requirement.
- ✓ The bidder submitted work experience documents of projects that do not match the information shown in the audit report. The differences in project details and financial records indicate misrepresentation. Therefore, the bid is considered non-responsive due to inconsistent and misleading qualification information.

3. Aman Buli WWC JV with Feleke Gerbi WWGC

- ✓ The bidder failed to submit the required credit facility for the joint venture. The credit facility was provided by only one member
- ✓ The bidder submitted work-specific experience documents for projects that do not meet the minimum required specific experience. This indicates misrepresentation of experience.

4. Ameka WWC PLC

- ✓ The bidder's trade registration date is 2/12/2014 E.C.; however, the bidder submitted work experience and audited financial statements covering periods prior to the trade registration date, which indicates misrepresentation of experience
- ✓ The bidder was not in the construction industry during the required period, and therefore does not meet the experience criteria stipulated in the bidding document.
